

Lakota Native American Camp



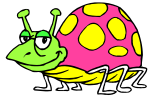
Let's make delicious fry bread, do beadwork, and learn about the Lakota's history inside our own full-size tipi! This camp is full of Native American crafts, stories and games!

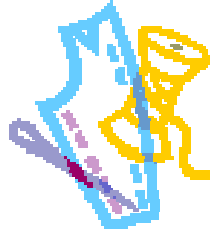
